Exhibition Rules and Guidelines

The following are to benefit all participants, and will be enforced throughout the festival:

All booths must be ready to open by 6:00 pm, and remain open until 10:00 pm Sat. evening.

Deviation from items listed on your application could result in the closing of your booth. A Temporary Food Service permit is not required from each vendor since Cleveland Better Home Town is the sponsor of this event and is a 501 (c) tax-exempt organization. However, the White County Health Department will be conducting a courtesy inspection of each vendor the morning of the event. Each vendor will have to meet the Health Departments requirements in order to serve food.

Indicate if your booth requires a electricity outlet. If you require the use of more than one outlet you must get prior approval.

There will be no rain date. A registration is a commitment to show.

Each exhibitor must provide his or her own display. This is an OUTDOOR event. Come prepared for all weather conditions. Freestanding canopies or trailers are recommended. Any stakes, weights or other "tie-down" equipment must remain inside booth dimensions. Be considerate of your neighbors. Tables MUST be draped to the ground on ALL FOUR SIDES. If you require additional space, you must get prior approval. All spaces are on pavement and some spots may have uneven terrain within the assigned space, come prepared.

Your display should be attractive and operated in good taste. We would like each booth to have as a theme "Fabulous 50's." No participant may sell illegal or immoral items. Cleveland Better Home Town reserves the right to disallow selling of disruptive, dangerous, damaging, etc. items. Anyone in violation of these restrictions will be escorted off the premises immediately. THIS IS A FAMILY ORIENTED EVENT.

Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting and reporting appropriate sales tax.

SET-UP BEGINS: Saturday, July 26, 4:30pm (Vehicles MUST be moved to designated parking by 5:00 PM) **BREAKDOWN:** Saturday, July 26 after 10 p.m. only (No early breakdown or departure). Must be off grounds by 11:00 p.m. Bring trash bags to clean up your area prior to departure.

YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO HAVE A VEHICLE AT YOUR BOOTH, NO EXCEPTIONS!

**All food vendors for the Fabulous 50's on the Square
will have to abide by the following requirements as put forth
from the White County Health Department:**

1. **Only those potentially hazardous foods requiring limited preparation, such as seasoning and cooking may be prepared and served. The preparation of other potentially hazardous foods, including pastries filled with cream or synthetic cream, custards, and similar products, and salads containing meat, poultry, eggs or fish are PROHIBITED.**
2. Potentially hazardous foods that are brought to the site must be maintained at less than or equal to 41 degrees Fahrenheit or at 140 degrees Fahrenheit or higher.
3. Any potentially hazardous foods that are cooked at the site must be protected from contamination and must be served within one (1) hour after being cooked. This includes such items as hamburgers, hot dogs, sausages, etc.
4. Ice that is used for drinks or for the storage of food must be from an approved source. Bagged ice from a store or grocery store should be okay.
5. Each vendor must have at their booth or cart a means by which to wash their hands. This requirement may be met by the use of filling a Coleman type cooler with clean potable (city or county water). The spout will need to be one that can be turned on and off. A pump bottle of hand wash soap is required and they must use paper towels to dry their hands. The water from the hand wash station must drain into a large bucket and the wastewater from this operation must be disposed of in a sink that runs to sanitary sewer. It is recommended that the vendor also use a hand sanitizer gel intermittently between hand washing.
6. A sink at the site needs to be provided to the vendors for the washing and sanitizing of utensils, unless the vendor has an approved means to wash and sanitize utensils and pans on his trailer or cart.
7. All food must be served on disposable plates with individual commercially prepackaged disposable eating utensils.
8. The cooking and preparation of any foods must be at least 8 feet from a customer area, and foods shall be adequately protected from dust and insects.
9. A courtesy inspection by the White County Health Department will occur prior to the start of the event. Should this inspection result in a recommendation by the Health Department not to serve an item, the vendor agrees to adhere to such recommendation. Our goal is to assure the health and welfare of our guests at the event. Food safety is of the utmost importance.
